RECOGNITION ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the institution Kithana College of Education, Plot No. 167/180, Khasara No. 167/349, 180/353, Street No. NRW Road, Village-Kithana, Post Office- Kithana, Tehsil/Taluka-Rajound, Town/City-Kithana, District-Kaithal-136044, State- Haryana, had submitted application online BA.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. Programme on 30.06.2015 to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for Teacher Education Course.

2. AND, WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal, veracity of the facts & figures as per the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of visiting team report including video graphy and also the reply submitted by the institution in compliance to the decision of clause 7(13) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time the Northern Regional Committee having satisfied itself that the institution fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and the extant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the proposed Teacher Education course, such as, instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the course and has selected/appointed qualified teaching staff as per norms duly approved by the affiliating body, decided to grant recognition/ permission to the institution in its 356th (Virtual) Emergent Meeting of the NRC, NCTE held on 02nd December, 2021 for BA.B.Ed./B.Sc. B.Ed. course for 100 seats.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition/permission to the following institution for conducting Teacher Education programme with an annual intake mentioned against its name from the academic Session 2022-23 under clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, subject to fulfilment of the conditions mentioned below: -

4. The other important details of the institution are as under:

5. The institution shall adhere to the fulfillment of the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, and ensure the following before commencement of the session: -

- (i) The institution shall comply with various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, as amended from time to time.
- (ii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of Clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- (iii) The institution shall comply with condition laid down in clause 8(3) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended vide Notification on 29.04.2017 which provides as under:
 - An institution, which has been recognised by the Council shall obtain accreditation from an accrediting agency identified by the Council within five years of the date of recognition.
 - All existing Teacher Education Institutions which have not been accredited so far or have not been accredited within five years from the date of its recognition shall be required to get themselves accredited by the aforesaid accrediting agency within a period of one year from the date of notification of these Regulations.
 - The accreditation once obtained shall be valid for a period of five years and the recognised and already accredited Teacher Education Institutions shall be required to get accreditation renewed by the agency identified for the purpose by the Council before the lapse of the earlier accreditation.
- (iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
- (v) The Norms for teaching staff in respect of their qualifications and experience shall be as per provisions of NCTE Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, State Government etc. as applicable, and compliance of the following by the affiliating body, State Govt and also the concerned recognised Institution: -

- (i) The affiliating body/State Govt. shall be required to verify the authenticity of the land & building documents submitted by the institution, with the required land & built up area as well as appointment of requisite teaching & non-teaching staff as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 before grant of affiliation to the institution.
- (ii) The affiliating body shall ensure that the institution is a composite institution as per definition of a "composite institution" given in the NCTE Regulation, 2014. If at any stage, it is found that the institution is not a composite institution, the

recognition granted shall be treated as withdrawn and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution. However, the existing stand-alone institutions shall gradually move towards becoming composite institutions.

(iii) The NOC of the affiliating body and staff approval thereof submitted by the institution, if found fake, at any stage, the recognitions granted shall be treated as withdrawn, and the sole responsibility of the same will be of the institution.

7. The institution shall submit a Self-Appraisal Report to the Regional Committee at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

8. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display as mandatory disclosure the following: -

- (i) Copy of Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars
- (iii) Staff Profile
- (iv) Recognition Order
- (v) Information regarding fulfillment of norms & standards and other conditions for the course.

9. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by the MHRD.

10. The Institution shall fill the GIS Application within one month from the date of issue of this order.

11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules and Regulations, the Regional Committee shall withdraw recognition under provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

12. Further, if the institution is not satisfied with the Order, it may prefer an Appeal under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 through "online mode" available on NCTE's website www.ncte-india.org within 60 days from the date of issue of this order. The guidelines for filing appeal may be seen on NCTE's website.

Regarding Grant of Provisional affiliation to start the B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. 4 years integrated Course from the session 2022-23 in Kithana College of Education, VPO- Kithana, Narwana Road, Kaithal.

Sir/ Madam,

This is with reference to your letter No. 180/KCEK/2022 dated 10.5.2022 on the subject cited above.

In this connection, I am to inform you that on the recommendations of the Inspection Committee, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor has allowed to your college for grant of provisional affiliation to start ~~start~~ the B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed. 4 years integrated Course from the session 2022-23 in Kithana College of Education, VPO- Kithana, Narwana Road, Kaithal. The Inspection Committee has indicated that the Management has fulfilled the 70% requirements/conditions..

The observations of the Committee are as under:-

1. The College has all the required documents available with them such as registration of the management, Sanction of NCTE to start the said course details of endowment funds.
2. The College has sufficient lecture rooms with sufficient furniture and laboratories for the requirement of the course.
3. The College has some equipments in the laboratory required to start the course.
4. The College has appointed teachers/Assistant professors (16) for the course and have University approval letter for them. Their details, approval letter, appointment letter and id of each are enclosed.
5. As per information by the Principal the staffs has joined w.e.f. April 01, 2022. 11 Assistant Professors were present on the day of inspection. Their attendance details and reason of absence of other five is enclosed.
6. The College has also appointed non-teaching staff also; their details and ids are enclosed.
7. College has initiated purchase of Books for the course; however there is need to further strengthen the library.
8. The College has its WEB SITE and E mail id and has certified that it is updated timely.
9. The College is using LPG cylinders for meeting the requirement of B.Sc. classes.
10. The College is having Distillation plant in one of the Laboratory.
11. The College has No objection from Kurukshetra University to apply to NCTE for introduction of 4 year B.A.B.Ed and B.Sc.B.Ed course.
12. The College has certificate of building safety and fire safety by the Govt. Authority.


Recommendations:

1. The College may be allowed to start B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed 4 years integrated course (50 seats each) initially for the session 2022-23 and directed to:
 - a. Purchase few more books for B.Sc.B.Ed and B.A.B.Ed classes in each subject.
 - b. Have proper care for WiFi connectivity so that students can access from all areas of college.
 - c. Purchase and install Water cooler/s for students.

“Since the college has basic requirements of documents (registration of management, Sanction of NCTE to start course etc.), space (Lecture rooms, furniture, basic books), teaching and non teaching staff has been appointed. The Committee may be allowed to start B.A.B.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed course for the session 2022-23”.

Kindly note that it is only provisional affiliation, in case, the college is found deficient in infrastructural facilities/teaching faculty and/or acting in violation of University directions, Rules, Regulations, Ordinance etc., the college shall be liable for penalties/disciplinary action including withdrawal of provisional affiliation.
